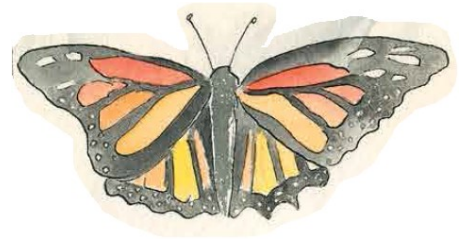


Monarch Mix-Up
